## **CONTEST RULES AND SCORING PROCEDURES**

Each event has specific criteria for scoring. The vendor “Event Sponsor” will design the lay-out and scoring process. Each registered contestant will be given a score sheet with their name on it to give to the judge. Safety is the first priority and violations of standard safety procedures such as neglecting to use your seat belt will result in being automatically disqualified. The judge for each event will explain their safety rules at the beginning of their event.

Each participating municipality will be allowed to submit one person from their agency per event. The same person can only compete in one individual event and 1 team event. If the contestant is not on site when they are scheduled to start, it will result in their disqualification and/or the disqualification of their team.

**Concrete Team:** Concrete event will begin at **9:00 AM on March 26** with a team of **3 members** preparing grade and setting forms. Sidewalks will be **4 feet wide** and **10 feet long** with no expansion material used. A strike joint will be required. A quiz will also be administered with MAG (Maricopa Associated Government) concrete specifications being used. These specifications will be sent to teams as they register.

Master Equipment Operator Contestants will have separate scoring sheets that will be distributed to the vendor “Event Sponsor” and turned into the MSA judges when completed. Master Equipment Operator may not compete in any other event.

For the “Best of the Best” competition, scoring will be based on the Municipality winning the most 1<sup>st</sup> place positions. In the case of a tie, the total of most 2<sup>nd</sup> place wins will be used to determine the winner.
